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# Abide in the True Vine

## Chapter 1

**"Jesus said, "I am the true vine,  
and my Father is the gardener."**

**John 15:1**

Hey friend, let's take a journey through the vineyard with Jesus. This moment was so very precious and special to Him and His disciples as He carefully shared so many secret truths with them. Soon He would no longer be with them.

In verse one of John 15 Messiah reaffirmed to them who He was and today still is. It was the seventh (7th) "I Am" which concluded His true character. He distinguished Himself from the wolves whose desire is to kill, steal and destroy His people. It was necessary that He shared these truths because the truth allowed them to be free and walk with and in Him with much power from Him.

The Teacher also used creative yet relational ways to share His message which allowed His disciples to understand. On this very day He told them that He is the True Vine. Interestingly He made it abundantly clear to use the word "true" before vine. In another version "Real Vine" is used. This indicates to us that if He stated He is the True Vine or rather "I am the True Vine...", there are other vines which try to imitate Him and lead His people astray.

True here means, "Rightly or strictly so called; genuine. Real or actual."

Real means "(of a thing) not imitation or artificial; genuine."

In essence Christ wanted His disciples to be aware of the snakes in the field. There were other sources which could potentially lead them astray and devour them. These sources would look like the real thing but not actually be the true source they needed in their walk with Him.

When we study the structure of the vine which Christ referred to, it's the part of the tree which is sturdy and firmly planted into the soil. He was not referring to the long, thin stem which creeps along the ground or climbs a wall. This sturdy part of the plant is actually the most important part for the sustenance, development and fruitfulness of the whole tree. This is the part where the branches of that vine would receive all the rich minerals and water in order for it to produce many delicious and healthy grapes for the gardener. The vine is also firmly planted into the soil from which it receives its resources to feed the entire tree. Their roots run extremely deep into the earth making it almost impossible for them to be uprooted easily. This deep connection to the earth is necessary for a long term sustenance of the tree. The gardener would only need to focus his attention in caring for the branches of the tree.



This makes sense why Jesus used the example of the Vine to illustrate who He is. He wanted His disciples and today, us, to understand the truth of His character and mission. He is the vine as described above and the connection to the soil displays how deeply He is sealed to the will of the Father. He is firmly rooted and grounded in the love and obedience of the Father that absolutely nothing can shake or uproot Him. He is Truth. He is Life. The branches being connected to the vine is vital because they are sustained by it. At any moment a branch breaks

off, the source of the mineral it once received is lost and it's highly possible that it will die. Hence it is imperative that as a son or daughter of Abba we must stay connected and in communion with the son Jesus.

If we choose to slip away due to any reason, we will lose the ability to live an abundant life through Christ. He is also the real deal; the true vine, any other source which we think is authentic actually is just a false imitation of Him and this will lead us astray. In order for us to receive all the promises written in His word we need to remain in union with Him.



His Father, He said, is the Gardener. A gardener is one “who tends and cultivates a garden as a pastime or for a living.” As the branches of that vine blossom, the gardener carefully assesses them and removes any dead leaf and then trims off what’s left so that they can produce a greater abundance of fruit. This is the job of our Father in the process. He oversees our growth and development in our connection to the son, Jesus. He watches us and tends to our needs when it is necessary.

He removes the things in our life which would bring death because He wants to ensure that we live a life full and free in Him. His ultimate desire is that we bear an abundance of fruit for His glory and by extension our joy in Him on this earth will be complete. We will reach a sense of true satisfaction which can never be attained by following after false vines in the world.

Take the time to reflect on His word and allow Holy Spirit to minister to you in your own special way. It's my prayer that He fully reveals to you what Him being the True and Real Vine means in your life as you aspire to live the Abundant Life!





# The Pruning

Chapter 2

He cuts off every branch in me that bears no fruit,  
while every branch that does bear fruit he prunes so  
that it will be even more fruitful.

John 15:2

From our last time spent together on *"Abide in the True Vine"*, we learned that Christ was speaking with His disciples and preparing them for His grand departure. It was essential that He took the time to carefully impart into their hearts these true words because it was these last words which brought their assignment all together. In verse one (1) He instructed them; who was the True Vine and who was the Gardener, to make it fundamentally clear who they (Father and Son) are in relation to the fake vines in the world.

In verse two (2) Christ describes the responsibility of the Gardener very distinctively and I can imagine He possibly illustrated this to them in the vineyard so that they could get a pictorial view of what the Father would be doing. I can picture the Father walking through His vineyard and carefully assessing the growth of every branch. Every dryness He observes he perhaps uses His shears to cut them off before it causes damage to the entire tree. He gathers all the unwanted and useless dead branches and dumps them to be burned. Let us remember that He is the Good Shepherd and the Good Shepherd always takes good care of His sheep.

Lovingly the Gardener who oversees our work, carefully removes all the dead fruits from our lives. During this season He calls us into training and refinement. We are under His care in this season and as we allow Him access, He begins to very strategically remove the fruits in our life that are causing us to fail and operate in the flesh. That's why the verse says that He cuts off every branch in us that bears no fruit. These branches must be removed otherwise He will not be able to consume us as effectively as He and even we desire. In order for Him to do so however we must grant Him access and permission to come in and do



what He desires to do. He isn't like a man who would boldly enter without permission. He wants our full approval before He can begin the work. Once He is welcomed and we willingly decide to surrender to His will the refinement begins. This process carries on throughout our walk with Him.



He observes that there are areas in our life that do not produce a sweet savour to Him and He decides to gracefully remove that branch. What He desires is that, our fruits produced will be sweet and eternally beneficial to the Kingdom of God. His Kingdom is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Ghost and this is what we must always aspire to attain. These areas that He desires to remove are operated by the works of flesh and they must be removed because the flesh is at constant war against the

Spirit. The good works the Lord wants to produce must be produced in a life that is fully consecrated to Him; one that lives in daily surrender to His will.

After our Gardener cuts off the poisonous fruits which would eventually lead us astray from Him, He tenderly trims our branches. Let us remember that He fits many caps as our Father. His skills as a porter are activated in the trimming process. He takes the time to mold and shape the vessel (us) until we have reached the shape and likeness He desires. Just like gold being refined in the fire, He doesn't stop until all the impurities are exempted from our life. He takes us from one level to another after every pruning stage but He continues to perfect His work in us until we meet Him face to face.

The more He prunes us into His image, the sweeter and greater quantity of fruits we will produce for His Kingdom. One of the characteristics of a fruit is that a seed is produced. That seed is hidden inside until it's ready to burst open. The more we allow Abba to refine us, the more seeds we produce down on the inside of us and at the appointed time we give birth to His seed(s) which will produce even more fruit. The whole point of being pruned by Him is so that we can produce an abundance of good fruit for the Kingdom of God. He wants that as we work for His Kingdom, we plant seeds in good soil so that it will grow and blossom to produce even greater fruit.

**Will you allow Abba the permission to prune you?**

**He desires to transform your life from the inside out so that you can produce Sweet and Eternal Fruits for His Kingdom. The amazing thing about this journey is that He blesses you with an abundant life as you surrender your life to Him.**

Chapter 3

**You have already been prepared to produce more fruit by the teaching I have given you.**

**John 15:3 ERV**

As I sit and reflect upon the words of John I begin to feel overwhelmed by the revelation the Lord gives. He lets you know in this season and on this very day that He already prepared you to produce more fruit as a result of all the classes you took with Him. This is the point at which He says to you; "You Are Ready".



Did He just say that? Did the Great Rabbi say that I am ready?

You began to believe that truly all things are possible even when it doesn't make sense. You were pressed but not crushed, persecuted but not abandoned, struck down but not destroyed. You are blessed beyond the curse because His promises endure that His joy is your strength.

(2 Corinthians 4)

The wilderness was made to bring out the treasure inside of you and me. There is a treasure in this earthen vessel of ours and everything that we went through was necessary to bring out the best in us and remove the things of the flesh. That's why along the journey Holy Spirit needed to encourage us to hold on because He was perfecting a good work inside of us. We didn't understand what He was doing fully but soon we will. # Live In Me

Chapter 4

**Stay joined to me and I will stay joined to you.  
No branch can produce fruit alone. It must stay connected  
to the vine. It is the same with you. You cannot produce  
fruit alone. You must stay joined to me.**

**John 15: 4**

Any other vine is fake and will lead us down a dark and dreadful road; one that leads to destruction. He has come to give us life and life more abundantly, so please remain in Him and choose life. Many generations will be blessed because of your obedience.

**“I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay joined to me, and I to you, you will produce plenty of fruit. But separated from me you won’t be able to do anything.**

**John 15:5**

As we reflect over the past four (4) chapters, abiding and simply walking with Christ through John 15:1-4, we see and feel much revelation imparted to us. He reiterates what He said in verse four (4) and tells us who we are on this tree; we are the branches, while He is the vine. A branch once connected to a tree will bring forth fruit and this is our mandate. We are to remain in connection with Him so that we can produce much fruit in the Kingdom of God.

***A condition is presented ...***

This production of fruit cannot be produced alone. He was sure to let us in on this vital detail. If we desire to produce fruit; fruit that will positively impact lives and draw them to the Father, we must choose to remain in Him.

When we decide to develop a sweet and intimate relationship with Christ, He takes the time to renew us and shape us. Once we choose to remain in Him and before we can produce fruit, He first refines us so that we can become pure as gold. We learn to lean and trust solely on Him and we begin to clearly understand why He is the True Vine. He renews our mindset. He changes our old pattern of thinking as we allow Him and we learn to put on the mind of Christ. He brings down this old temple of ours and carefully rebuilds one that honours Him.



He knows what He is doing while He is working in you. He knows that once the work inside is complete, you will not only produce fruit but an abundance of fruit. Your fruit will not only impact you and your family but also those very same people who stood against you. Those who hated you will see the change in you. They will recognise the power of God in your life and this will draw them to Christ. Everyone, far and wide will be fully aware of your fruits and after being impacted, they will go out and produce even more fruit.

**“But separated from me you won’t be able to do anything.”**

This tells us that we have a choice. We are never forced to do what we don’t want to do because perfect love casts out all fear. Therefore if we choose to seek other vines and pastures which are not of Him, we will soon find out that we cannot produce any fruit in His absence. It was clearly stated to the disciples and now to us that if we choose to disassociate ourselves from Him we will not produce any fruit.



In order for any branch to bear fruit, we are aware that this branch must be connected to the vine itself. In order for the branch to receive the necessary nutrients for its production of fruits and survival, it has to be connected to the vine. It's the very same situation for us. If we want to produce lasting fruit; 30,60 or even 100 folds, we must decide to stay connected to the only True Vine from which we will receive a True sustenance of Life. This life is not only eternal but we get the chance to live an abundant life on Earth. We will beautify every area we enter. Our fragrance will be so captivating that others will want to know more about us.

Choosing to remain in Christ will be the most important thing we could ever choose to do with our life. He is the true sustainer, He is the very breath we breathe. He is the Resurrection and the Life and only in Him will we find real life. We should desire more than anything else, a personal and intimate relationship with Him because He wants us to know more about Him. He wants us to experience Him deeper than we do now. There are hidden secrets about who He has created us to be that He would like to share with us. These secrets will further plunge us into our assignments for His Kingdom and we will produce even more fruit than now. He wants us to dig deeper in Him because He loves us and He wants us to experience all that He is.

There is so much in store for you right now with Him and He wants you to only remain in Him and seek after Him passionately. Choose to remain connected to the True Vine and He will truly show you how much He can completely and radically transform your life for His Glory. You will be amazed at what His Love will do. You will never be the same again. He wants you to not only read about the abundant life but truly and personally experience it because He Loves you.

# Never Produce Alone

Chapter 6

**If you do not remain in me, you are like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned.**

**John 15:6**

Picture this, during the fall season the leaves lose their green feature simply because of the change in season. During this season, the days get shorter and the plants get less exposure to the sunlight as compared to the spring and summer seasons. Thus the leaves will now only get a fraction of the necessary nutrients required from the sun as before and would have to be sustained by what is already in the leaf to maintain its life. As a result of the lack of sunlight, its main source to produce fruit is compromised. All leaves contain Chlorophyll which is the important substance that allows the plants to receive its green feature when exposed to the sunshine. When there is a lack of sunshine however, this substance in the plant is inhibited and therefore cannot operate as it was created to. Therefore the leaves begin to utilize the stored nutrients in its system until all has been consumed and all life is gone. The leaves may turn; yellow, red, orange, purple or brown and eventually fall off.

It's interesting when you study this process because what really happens in a nutshell is, when the leaves cannot get access to this main source, they begin to use up a secondary source that was never meant to sustain them for over a long period of time. Eventually when all this secondary source is used up, the leaves change colour and die. They change from their natural, verdant green colour which clearly depicts life and richness into something dry and hopeless. When these leaves fall onto the ground they are collected for disposal because at this point they are of no use to the tree anymore.

“Stay joined to me,” Christ said to His disciples “because apart from me you are nothing.” He reiterated this in hopes that they would grasp the importance of it because this point was fundamental. Straying away from the True Vine will cause us to fall. Similarly to the leaves of the tree, when they were in direct connection to the sunlight; their main powerful source which helped them to produce much fruit, they lacked nothing. They were flourishing and producing exactly what they needed to maintain themselves. They even produced excess which was utilized during the Fall season until all was consumed.

Let us assume the leaves represent us, the sunlight represents Jesus; the True Vine and the stored substances represent the secondary source. We shouldn't allow a change in season to determine whether or not we remain connected to Jesus, our True Vine. In other words we shouldn't allow a change in circumstances, a change in our environments, a change in our level on the job, a change in our status in society,



or a change in our financial situation to become a barrier for Jesus to get access to us. He wants His light to shine on us forever but if we become hindrances for His blessings to shine on us, we will eventually lose that glory we once had.

Let us assume the leaves represent us, the sunlight represents Jesus; the True Vine and the stored substances represent the secondary source. We shouldn't allow a change in season to determine whether or not we remain connected to Jesus, our True Vine. In other words we shouldn't allow a change in circumstances, a change in our environments, a change in our level on the job, a change in our status in society, or a change in our financial situation to become a barrier for Jesus to get access to us. He wants His light to shine on us forever but



if we become hindrances for His blessings to shine on us, we will eventually lose that glory we once had. It's funny how when we are in a season of great wealth we may feel like we no longer need Jesus, but He is the one who gave us the ability to produce wealth. If we choose to forsake Him and His teachings are no longer in us we will be punished. If we choose to act as if we are able to produce fruit alone, we will soon run out of resources just like the leaves and fall off the branch. This is the thing He warns us about. When we try to pursue life on our own, we will lose access to the one who gives true life and fruit. We will use up all our strength and then run out of resources and be burned out. While we may think that our works are producing fruits we would actually be producing useless fruit. These fruits produced out of self, cannot and will never sustain us over a long period of time. It was never meant to be this way . God never created us to operate in our own strength but rather through the strength and power of Jesus Christ who is the True Vine.

Do not think for a moment that You can sustain your own wealth. So quickly it will fade away when you do it alone. Instead, REMAIN in the True Vine. In the True Vine there will be an unending supply of rich nutrients which will allow you to produce MUCH FRUIT IN AND OUT OF SEASON. The changes in seasons, when you abide in Him, will not hinder the quality and quantity of fruit you produce. You will produce so much fruit all year round that others will marvel at the works of God's hands in your life. Remain planted by the rivers of water and your leaves will never wither. Whatsoever you do will prosper because you choose to abide and remain firmly planted in Him.

Those who try to produce fruit alone and allow the change in seasons to alter their connection with Christ will reap what they sow. When they think they are producing well, sustaining themselves without the True Vine, they will soon realise that all their work outside of Him was pointless. Their self sustenance will run out because we were never meant to produce alone. These leaves which are dried are then gathered for the purpose of being burned up.

If we fail to remain in Him our future will be similar to that of the old dried up branches; no hope, no use except for the purpose of bush fire. This shouldn't be our desire. Regardless of how much the Lord blesses you as a result of your fruit production and obedience, He says again, Stay In Me. Do not allow the blessings to trick you into thinking that now I can do this alone. No! Apart from Him we are nothing. Every good gift He has blessed us with is only a gift and came from Him. We cannot sustain ourselves outside of Him. When we remain in Him we have full access to all the daily resources we will ever need.

Chapter 7

**Stay joined together with me, and follow my teachings. If you do this, you can ask for anything you want, and it will be given to you. Show that you are my followers by producing much fruit. This will bring honor to my Father.**

**John 15: 7 & 8**

It has been a beautiful journey with the Messiah as we walked with Him through the Vineyard. He carefully instructed us the true way to follow, He pruned and refined us, He prepared us for our great assignments and then He reinforced His desire for us to remain only in Him. One of the reasons one may reiterate something is for emphasis or clarity. I think He wanted to do both, so that we wouldn't experience one ounce of confusion. We would also know where our true identity lies and from this position go out and do exactly what He created us to do. Once we know who we are, we begin to operate with a mindset of abundance from His perspective. We will work with such unearthly power and authority that people around who aren't connected to Him will be amazed at our level of excellence and accomplishments.

It's our obligation now to do as He has done. He tells us to "Follow His Teachings". In simple form, this means to obey Him. Obey the very words He gave you while you were on this journey with Him. He took the time to share with us many truths, mysteries and instructions, because these are important to our success on this earth. Straying away from these will cause us to get distracted, lose focus and fall off track from what He created us to do. Best way to walk this journey is to simply do as He said; *"stay joined together with me, and follow my teachings"*. We are reminded in His very Word that it is better to obey



than to make sacrifices. Sacrifices given to God outside of obedience will not be accepted. It would in essence be a waste of time. Please remain in deep connection with the True Vine because it is only through Him can you become your best self.

*Did I just say that? You can become your best self?* Yes, because it is true. He is able to transform you into a whole new creation. The old you will be completely eradicated and a NEW you will come forth, just like Lazarus. God is still rolling stones even to this very day! In an intimate relationship with Him, you will have free access to anything you want to be successful. Makes sense huh? A bastard child does not own rights to his father's possession but one who is accepted and is a part of the family, gets the freedom to receive anything he desires and is even appointed privileges he doesn't yet know about. Once we surrender our life to Him and remain in Him we become a member of the Royal Family; of the line of David. We become part of the in-circle and have access to unlimited wealth and blessings stored in heavenly places. The unlimited Key however will always remain true and thus I must stress this point to you my dear friend; **Stay joined to Him**. Outside of the family, blessings cannot follow us.



Being a part of the Kingdom of God is indeed a High Call. We are expected to live at a higher standard than the world. The world should see a fundamental difference in our life. We are responsible to produce much fruit on this earth as true ambassadors of God. Why? Anyone commissioned as an ambassador of a country is sent to another country to be a true representative of their home country. Everything that he or she does must be done in excellence because he/she is a reflection of their own country. How he/she speaks, walks, dresses, where he/she goes and how their work is done, must be done at a high standard otherwise they'd become an embarrassment for their country. It's pretty much the same with us as citizens of Heaven. Once accepted into the family of God, there are standards that we must operate by which brings glory to our Father. One of these is the quantity and quality of our fruits produced. He desires to see us, His beloved children not just join in, but truly represent Him by producing an abundance of fruit. Now that you are in, stay in but go out and produce, 30, 60 and even 100 folds. Produce as He tells you to, as if everyday is your last day. Bring honour to our Father by operating in true abundance.

I can sense now that after enduring the process of a quiet refining and pruning season, you are now ready to go out into the world and preach the Gospel of peace. Go out and produce. Share the Gospel in all the diversified ways Abba tells you to. There are souls who need to hear and see you and perhaps even read your content. Be the best creative artist, designer, pastor, evangelist, teacher, mother, manager, planner, friend, counsellor, cashier, architect, chef you name it, as you have been created to be. Decide to be your best in Christ and leave this world empty. Go out and produce much fruit, continue in His love and teachings and remember to stay joined eternally to Him.
